LEARN MORE ABOUT NEW STATE LAWS AND GET YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATIONS BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS.

THIS IS AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE RILEY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

For the 2019-2020 school year, Kansas is updating the school immunization requirements to more closely reflect the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention and the American Academy of Pediatrics recommended immunization schedule.

The revised regulation will require vaccination against hepatitis A (already a daycare requirement) and will require meningococcal (Serotype A, C, W, Y) for entry into 7th and 11th grades.
